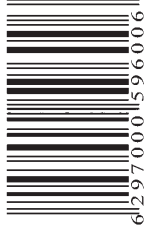

## World Bank raises forecast for UAE's real GDP growth to 3.9% in 2024; 4.1% in 2025

WASHINGTON/WAM

The World Bank has raised its forecast for the UAE's real GDP growth to 3.9% in 2024, compared to its previous forecast in January of 3.7%. In an economic update on the latest economic developments in the Middle East and North Africa region, the World Bank said it had raised its forecast for the UAE's economic growth to 4.1% in 2025 from its previous forecast of 3.8%.

The report also indicated that the UAE's current account surplus is estimated to rise to 8.4% in 2024 and 8.3% in 2025, and that the country will achieve a surplus of 5.1% in its fiscal balance by the end of this year and 4.8% next year.

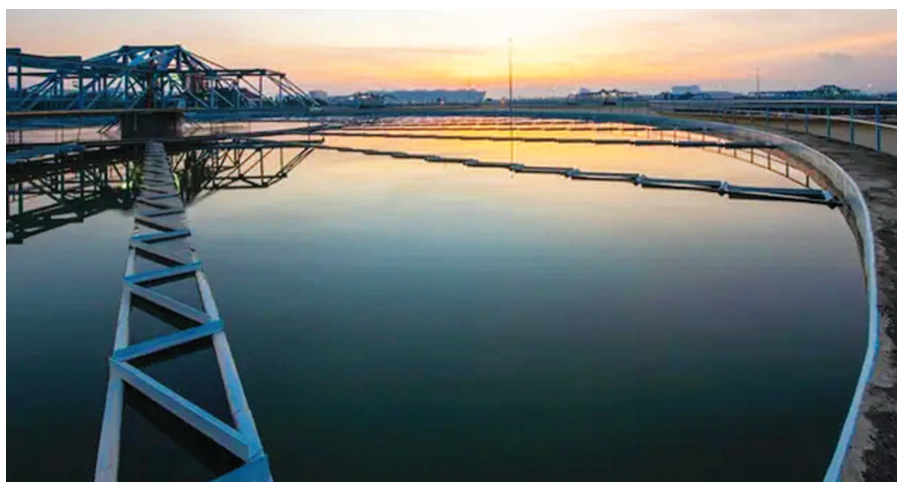

This initiative is part of the UAE's broader effort to manage water resources sustainably and aims to drive investment, accelerate technological innovation, enhance international cooperation, and raise awareness of the severity of water scarcity.

EtihadWE boasts a significant RO production capacity at facilities like NAQA'A, Ghalila, and Zawrah, totaling approximately 190 Million Imperial Gallons per Day (MIGD). RO technology, known for being more energy-efficient than thermal desalination, plays a crucial

## UN Chief Guterres calls for de-escalation in Middle East

NEW YORK / WAM

United Nations Secretary-General António Guterres said that the people of the Middle East are facing a real danger of a devastating full-scale conflict, urging "maximum restraint" across a region "on the brink".

Speaking at an emergency meeting of the UN Security Council, with representatives from Israel, Iran, and Syria present, to address recent developments between Iran and Israel, Guterres underscored the imperative to de-escalate tensions, exercise utmost restraint, and step back from the brink of conflict.



UN Secretary-General António Guterres added that there was a similar responsibility to secure an immediate humanitarian ceasefire in Gaza, the immediate and unconditional release of all hostages, and the unimpeded delivery of humanitarian aid

The Secretary-General reiterated to all United Nations members the principles enshrined in the United Nations Charter, which strictly forbid the use of force against regional stability or the political sovereignty of any nation.

Furthermore, he highlighted the importance of upholding the sanctity of diplomatic and consular premises, along with their personnel, in accordance with international law under all circumstances.

"It is vital to avoid any action that could lead to major military confrontations on multiple fronts in the Middle East... Now is the time for maximum restraint," the UN Secretary-General told delegates at the opening of the UN Security Council meeting.

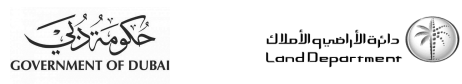

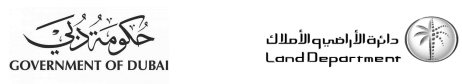

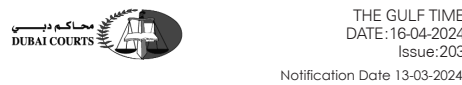

According to a report published by the *People's Daily*, China's substantial role in fostering the global shift towards green and low-carbon initiatives continues to garner global recognition, identifying the nation as a pivotal catalyst in the global transition towards sustainable energy practices and en-

Collectively, these endeavours constituted roughly 41 percent of the global reduction in carbon emissions attributed to renewable energy.

China has emerged as a global leader in various new energy technologies and equipment manufacturing, establishing the world's largest clean power supply



## ADB forecasts developing Asia's economy to grow 4.9% in 2024

Developing economies in Asia and the Pacific are forecast to expand by 4.9% on average this year as the region continues its resilient growth amid robust domestic demand, improving semiconductor exports, and recovering tourism.

Growth will continue at the same rate next year, according to the Asian Development Outlook (ADO) April 2024, by the Asian Development Bank (ADB). Inflation is expected to moderate in 2024 and 2025, after being pushed up by higher food prices in many economies over the past two years.

Stronger growth in South and Southeast Asia—fuelled by both domestic demand and exports—is offsetting a slowdown in the People's Republic of China (PRC) caused by weakness in the property market and subdued consumption. India is expected to remain a major growth engine in Asia and the Pacific, with a 7.0% expansion this year and 7.2% next year. The PRC's growth is forecast to slow to 4.8% this year and 4.5% next year, from 5.2% last year.

economies in developing Asia this year and next," said ADB Chief Economist Albert Park. "Consumer confidence is improving, and investment is resilient overall. External demand also appears to be turning a corner, particularly with regard to semiconductors."

Policymakers should remain vigilant, however, as there are a number of risks. These include supply chain disruptions, uncertainty about US monetary policy, the effects of extreme

weather, and further property market weakness in the PRC.

Inflation in developing Asia and the Pacific is expected to decline to 3.2% this year and 3.0% next year, as global price pressures ease and as monetary policy remains tight in many economies. However, for the region excluding the PRC, inflation is still higher than before the Covid-19 pandemic. Rice prices have contributed to higher food inflation, especially for im-

port-reliant economies. Prices for rice are likely to stay elevated this year, according to ADO April 2024. Reasons include crop losses due to adverse weather and India's restrictions on rice exports. Increased global shipping costs, due to attacks against ships in the Red Sea and drought in the Panama Canal, may also add to inflation in Asia, according to the report.

To tackle surging rice prices and protect food security, governments can give targeted subsidies to vulnerable populations and enhance market transparency and monitoring to prevent price manipulation and hoarding. In the medium to longer term, policy should focus on establishing strategic rice reserves to stabilise prices, promoting sustainable farming and crop diversification, and investing in agricultural technology and infrastructure to raise productivity. Regional cooperation can also help manage rice prices and their impact, the report says.

ADB is committed to achieving a prosperous, inclusive, resilient, and sustainable Asia and the Pacific, while sustaining its efforts to eradicate extreme poverty.

## China-Europe freight train services expand by 9% in Q1

China-Europe freight train services registered solid expansion in terms of network coverage and freight growth in the first quarter of 2024, data from China's railway operator showed.

China State Railway Group Co, Ltd (China Railway) stated that during the initial three months, there were a cumulative total of 4,541 journeys undertaken by China-Europe freight trains, facilitating the transportation of approximately 493,000 TEUs of goods.

This marks a respective increase of 9 percent and 10 percent in comparison to the preceding year.

According to *China Central Television*, several factors have contributed to freight growth. The first one is the expansion of the China-Europe freight train network.

Second, transport efficiency and capability have been elevated at ports. Third, transportation service quality has been improved overtime.

## India's 'mission' announces 4 thematic technology hubs

India is setting up four thematic hubs in the domains of Quantum Computing, Quantum Communication, Quantum Sensing Metrology, and Quantum Material Devices as part of its National Quantum Mission by leveraging national strengths in this sector.

This announcement was made by the Office of Principal Scientific Advisor to the Government of India on the occasion of World Quantum Day,

which has been observed annually on 14th April since 2022 under the United Nations auspices.

Quantum Mechanics is the study of atoms and sub-atomic particles. It has now advanced to such an extent that it is used to develop technologies such as light-emitting diodes (LEDs), lasers and ultra-precise atomic clocks used in the Global Positioning System (GPS).
