The IPO market in the Middle East and North Africa (Mena) region remained resilient during the second quarter of this year, with 14 IPOs registering total proceeds of \$2.64 billion, up 45.3 percent compared to the same period last year.

Saudi Manpower Solutions Company (SMASCO) raised Saudi Arabia's second-largest Initial Public Offring amount, according to the Ernst & Young report

According to the Ernst & Young report on IPO activity in the Mena region, the second quarter of this year saw the listing of Dr Soliman Abdul Kader Fakeeh Hospital Co on Saudi Arabia's main market, raising \$764 million, 29 percent of the region's IPO proceeds for the quarter, followed by Abu Dhabi Securities Exchange's (ADX) listing of Alef Education Consultancy

AD Ports Group reports 42% growth in total net profit in Q2

The company's revenues more than doubled YoY to AED4.18 billion and EBITDA soared 56% YoY to AED1.07 billion in the second guarter of 2024

AD Ports Group on Tuesday announced that its total net profit reached AED439 million in Q2 2024, an increase of 42% Year-on-Year (YoY), while the net profit after minorities reached AED333 million in Q2 2024, an increase of 16% YoY.

In a press release, the company said that revenues have more than doubled YoY to AED4.18 billion in Q2 2024. The increase was driven by organic growth in the Ports, Logistics and Digital Clusters, and by the acquisitions of Noatum and GFS on the inorganic front.

EBITDA soared 56% YoY to AED1.07 billion in Q2 2024, a rise of 8% YoY on an Like-For-Like (LFL) basis, while the EBITDA margin stood at 25.6% in the same period.

Federal Tax Authority issues clarification on first period of Corporate Tax

The Federal Tax Authority (FTA) confirmed that the first Tax Period of a newly established company, in respect of a juridical person subject to Corporate Tax, is determined by the first Financial Year, as stipulated under the Commercial Companies Law. The Corporate Tax Law applies to Tax Periods commencing on or after June 1, 2023, and the Tax Period for the Taxable Person is the Financial Year or part thereof for which a Tax Return is required to be filed

filed.

This information was provided in a recent Public Clarification issued by the FTA to increase awareness regarding the first Tax Period for Corporate Tax for juridical persons. The Public Clarification also addresses the timeline for Tax Deregistration in case of the cessation of Businesses or Business Activities before or during the first Tax Period

ing the first Tax Period.

According to the Public Clarification issued by the FTA, for newly established companies under the Commercial Companies Law, if the first Financial Year begins on or after 1st June 2023, this Financial Year is considered the first Tax Period for

Corporate Tax purposes.

If the Financial Year under the

According to the public clarification, the Corporate Tax Law applies to Tax Periods commencing on or after June 1, 2023, and the Tax Period for the Taxable Person is the Financial Year or part thereof for which a Tax Return is required to be filed

Commercial Companies Law is not a standard 12-month period but ranges between 6 and 18 months, the FTA accepts this period as the first Tax Period for Corporate Tax purposes. However, if the first Financial Year begins before 1st June 2023, the first Tax Period will be the subsequent 12-month Financial Year that begins on or after 1st June, 2023, with each subsequent Tax Period being the 12 months following the end of the first Tax Period. In a press statement issued on Tuesday, the FTA stated that the new Public Clarification aims to shed light on the first Tax Period for Corporate Tax purposes.

EAD reports rare red-footed booby bird on Qarnain Island, Al Dhafra Region

The Environment Agency – Abu Dhabi (EAD) has reported that it has spotted a red-footed booby, a rare member of the booby family, during periodic monitoring operations on Qarnain Island in the Arabian Gulf region.

Considered one of the rarest and smallest booby species, the red-footed booby species are widespread on the coasts and islands of tropical areas, yet remain rare in the region, due to the lack of resident groups in the country.

Consisting of mainly fish and squid, the red-footed booby's diet confirms its im-

portant role in the balance of the marine ecosystem, and although rare, the species is not considered threatened according to the IUCN Red List. The monitoring of this bird

represents a unique opportunity for a deeper understanding of wildlife and the importance of preserving natural habitats.

Ahmed Al Hashemi, Execu-

tive Director of the Terrestrial and Marine Biodiversity Sector at EAD, said: "This bird, which gets its name due to the red colour of its feet, has been added to the list of 426 bird species recorded in Abu Dhabi. Since 2005, the Environment Agency - Abu Dhabi has implemented a long-term programme to monitor migratory birds and major breeding species with the aim of protecting and preserving them. This helps to assess the status of breeding species and monitor migratory birds, including birds of prey and waterfowl that are important regionally and globally."

UAE Govt's New Federal Decree-Law amends Domestic Workers Law

The UAE Government has issued a Federal Decree-Law amending specific provisions of the Federal Decree-Law Concerning Domestic Workers and its Amendments. These amendments aim to strengthen the rights of all parties involved in employment relationships, as well as facilitate and accelerate resolving disputes.

The new decree amends the jurisdiction for disputes related to domestic workers, transferring such cases from the Court of Appeal to the Court of First Instance. The Courts of Appeal are required to transfer all pending applications, disputes, and grievances to the Court of First Instance as they are, without any fees, effective from the date the present Law takes effect.

This does not apply to cases that have already been sentenced by the judge or held in the court's pipeline for sentencing.

The Law stipulates that if a dispute arises between the employer, the domestic worker, or the recruitment company and cannot be re-

solved amicably, the issue must be referred to the Ministry of Human Resources and Emiratisation.

The Ministry is empowered to take the appropriate measures to settle the dispute amicably, in line with the procedures set out in this Law's Executive Regulations and the effective decisions.

Yalla Group Limited, the largest Middle East and North Africa (Mena)-based online social networking and gaming company, on Tuesday announced its unaudited financial results for the second quarter of the fiscal year 2024, ending on June 30.

The financial results revealed that Yalla's H1 revenues have surpassed AED 587.3 million (\$159.9 million), recording a 4.7% increase from the first half of the previous year. Moreover, H1 net income saw a substantial rise, climbing to AED 229.6 million (\$62.5 million), showing an impressive increase of 29.7% from the first half of the previous year. This remarkable financial performance was largely driven by robust results in the




