FTA processes 2.7 million tourist tax refund requests in H1

The authority said that 19.67m transactions were processed since the launch of the digital VAT refund system until June

The Federal Tax Authority (FTA) asserted there has been considerable growth in the volume of transactions processed through the digital Value Added Tax (VAT) refund system for tourists in 2024, surging to 2.7 million in the first half of the year, up from 2.55 million requests recorded during the same period in 2023.

The figures are based on the number of refund "Tax free Tag" issued by retail stores electronically linked to the system, and add up to a daily average of approximately 15,000 transactions, compared to 14,180 in the same period of 2023, marking an increase of 5.62 percent.

In a press statement issued on Monday, the authority revealed

Al Bustani added. "The system is the most advanced of its kind in the world and offers 100 percent digital procedures to process digital invoices issued from retail outlets registered in the system,

replacing traditional paper invoices, using an advanced electronic link between these outlets and the system. This allows for issuing, sending, modifying, and storing invoices electronically between the seller, the tourist making the purchase, and the system, which also offers programmed built-in verification procedures to ensure eligibility for tax refunds according to the relevant tax legislation."

The workshop focused on the latest systems implemented in managing rehabilitation and correctional centres, aiming to exchange knowledge, expertise, and learn from international best practices in the field. The goal is to enhance Abu Dhabi's competitive position on the global stage.

The workshop is part of a series organised by the ADJD in coordination with regional and international judicial authorities. This aligns with the directives of His Highness Sheikh Mansour bin Zayed Al Nahyan,

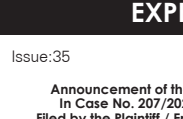

India to introduce digital ‘Unified Lending Interface’

BENGALURU / WAM

India’s technology platform for providing “frictionless credit” launched by the Reserve Bank of India (RBI) last year as a pilot project will be introduced nationwide soon, said Shaktikanta Das, Governor of RBI, on Monday.

This technology platform will be named “Unified Lending Interface (ULI)”, *Asian News International (ANI)* quoted Das as saying at the Global Conference on Digital Public Infrastructure and Emerging Technologies in Bengaluru.

The governor said, “Just like UPI (Unified Payments Interface – India’s instant payment system) transformed the payments ecosystem, we expect that ULI will play a similar role in transforming the lending space in India.”

The new ULI platform facilitates a seamless and consent-based flow of digital information, including even land records of various states, from multiple data service providers to lenders. The technology platform introduced last year as a pilot project cuts down the time taken for credit appraisal, especially for small and rural borrowers.

“This reduces the complexity of multiple technical integrations. It enables borrowers to get the benefit of seamless delivery of credit, and quicker turnaround time without requiring extensive documentation,” the RBI Governor said.

Speaking about the success of Unified Payment Interface (UPI), Das said, “The current ecosystem of digital payments in India offers a bouquet of simple, safe, and secure options for instant or quick transfer of funds, both large and small value, for businesses and individuals.”

Dr Thani Al Zeyoudi, Minister of State for Foreign Trade, has held talks with Pham Minh Chinh, Prime Minister of Vietnam, during a visit to Hanoi for a series of meetings with representatives from the public and private sectors to explore opportunities for stronger bilateral trade and investment ties.

The talks focused on deepening cooperation in sectors considered crucial to both nation’s economic growth and diversification agendas, which include renewable energy, logistics, manufacturing, technology and agriculture.

Dr Thani Al Zeyoudi, who was accompanied by Dr Bader Abdulla Saeed bin Saeed AlMatrooshi, UAE Ambassador to Vietnam, also met Nguyễn Hồng Diên, Vietnam’s Minister of Industry and Trade, to discuss how to expand bilateral non-oil trade, which reached \$6.1 billion in the first half of 2024, with growth of nine percent and 34 percent compared to the corresponding period in 2023 and 2022, and solidifying Vietnam’s status as the UAE’s leading trade partner in the Association of Southeast Asian Nations (ASEAN) region. The two sides also reviewed progress towards a Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement, which will, once concluded and implemented, accelerate trade and investment flows by removing tariffs, simplifying customs procedures and improving market access for services exporters.

Al Zeyoudi also discussed the far-reaching benefits of the CEPA throughout talks with Nguyen Ba Hoan, Deputy Minister of Labour - Invalids and Social Affairs, and Tran Thanh Nam, Deputy Minister of
