AD Ports hosts 1st ship-to-ship LNG bunkering at Khalifa Port

The operation reinforces Abu Dhabi’s position as a significant hub for alternative marine fuels and sustainable maritime solutions

AD Ports Group recently hosted its first ship-to-ship (STS) liquified natural gas (LNG) bunkering operation at its flagship deep-water Khalifa Port, reinforcing Abu Dhabi’s position as a key hub for alternative marine fuels and sustainable maritime solutions.

The STS bunkering was part of a simultaneous operation in which the container vessel MSC Thais - berthed at Abu Dhabi Terminals, received LNG fuel from the dedicated LNG bunker vessel Green Zeebrugge, supplied by marine fuels provider Monjasa.

The operation demonstrated the concurrent transfer of LNG and cargo, in addition to highlighting AD Ports Group’s ability to integrate complex and efficient services into its port infrastructure and operations, whilst facilitating access to lower-carbon fuels, which support both the industry and global environmental objectives.

AD Ports Group and Monjasa will continue expanding LNG bunkering services across the group’s commercial ports in Abu Dhabi, including cruise vessels at Zayed Port, while offering a comprehensive fuel portfolio that includes Very Low Sulphur Fuel Oil (VLSFO), Marine Gas Oil (MGO), and High-Sulfur Fuel Oil (HSFO)

The STS operation was executed in accordance with international best practices and regulatory standards, that include LNG bunkering protocols and guidelines set by the International Maritime Organisation (IMO), International Association of Ports and Harbors (IAPH), International Organisation for Standardisation (ISO), and Society of International Gas Tanker and Terminal Operators (SIGTTO). With this achievement, AD Ports Group is accelerating the shift toward sustainable marine fuels, while reinforcing Abu Dhabi’s leadership in the global energy transition and advancing the UAE’s Net Zero 2050 Strategy.

MBRU identifies genetic disorder affecting children

Scientists at Mohammed Bin Rashid University of Medicine and Health Sciences (MBRU), which leads the Learning and Discovery missions of Dubai Health, have identified a novel genetic disorder affecting children’s growth and development.

Published in a leading journal, *The American Journal of Human Genetics*, MBRU’s study identifies a problem in the FBX022 gene, which causes various health issues in children, including growth restriction, intellectual disability, and other physical challenges.

This discovery made by scientists at Mohammed Bin Rashid University of Medicine and Health Sciences could enable more accurate diagnosis and genetic counseling, supporting informed family planning and long-term care for affected families.

Unlike traditional tower inspections, autonomous drones can navigate complex environments autonomously, enhancing worker safety and operational efficiency. They also play a vital role in emergency response, supporting the delivery of critical aid and connectivity in hard-to-reach areas.

Through advanced artificial intelligence analytics, the drones instantly detect structural anomalies during

A device by university students to assist stroke patients won 2nd place in the Huawei Tech4Good Global Competition 2025

A team of university students from the UAE has successfully developed an innovative and practical device designed to assist stroke patients with impaired hand movement, aiming to support their independence in daily life.

The team won second place in the Huawei Tech4Good Global Competition 2025, held in Shenzhen, China, and was selected among the top 12 finalist teams worldwide.

The winning team comprised seven distinguished students: Sultan Al Samaj, Maryam Al Dhaheri, Muna Al Qaidi, Fatima Al Hammadi, Hamad Al Marzouqi, Ali Zainal and Ahmed Al Muhairi. The team was honourarily chaired and supervised by Prof Dr Wathiq Mansoor, Dean of the College of Engineering and IT

enabled significant progress.

The team’s journey began with their participation in the Tech4Good Regional Competition in Uzbekistan in 2024, where they secured second

place in the regional semi-finals held in Tashkent. This success qualified them for the global finals in China, where they competed against elite international teams.

The project integrates cutting-edge technologies such as 3D scanning and printing, Bluetooth connectivity and mobile applications to produce a device tailored to the specific needs of stroke patients.

Currently, the team is working on refining the device prototype based on feedback from mentors, peers and experts. They have started 3D printing the device and testing its electronic components. Additionally, they have initiated collaborations with the Ministry of Health and hospitals across the UAE to obtain medical insights that ensure the device’s efficiency and user-friendliness.

Development (OECD) on Global Anti-Base Erosion (GloBE) Rules (Pillar Two).

This decision follows the issuance of Cabinet Decision No (142) of 2024 regarding the imposition of a Top-up Tax on Multinational

Enterprises.

This decision reaffirms the UAE’s continued commitment to applying international standards and best practices in the field of taxation, in line with the OECD Inclusive Framework on Base Erosion and Profit

Shifting (BEPS), of which the UAE is a member.

The ministry clarified that the adoption of the new decision includes all Administrative Guidance and relevant commentary issued by the OECD up to January 2025.
