In a major step towards deepening the UAE-Italy strategic relations, G42, the leading AI technology group from Abu Dhabi, through its subsidiary Core42, on Tuesday announced a strategic partnership with iGenius, a pioneer in AI models for highly regulated industries, to deliver the largest AI compute deployment in Europe.

The partnership reflects the growing momentum in bilateral ties, aligned with both nations’ leadership vision to drive innovation, enable economic advancement, and create shared value through advanced technology and knowledge exchange.

The agreement is intended to establish a robust framework for collaboration, positioning G42 as a trusted enabler of global digital transformation - particularly highlighting Core42’s pivotal role in the AI infrastructure partnership. It also reflects the shared ambition to embed AI into critical value chains, fostering regional resilience and long-term sustainable growth.

Al Ghadeer Emirati Crafts, a non-profit that trains women in handicrafting using techniques like Talli, Khous, Sadu and pottery, is among the exhibitors. The organisation has trained over 470 women, transforming traditional crafts into contemporary products such as handbags and home

décor. Their work has been showcased at international exhibitions in the UK, Italy, China and beyond.

Also exhibiting is Khunair, the heritage brand of Beit Al Khunair, which produces handcrafted Emirati daggers, coffee pots and ceremonial artefacts using traditional methods passed down through generations. The brand seeks to revitalise interest in heritage crafts and position them as valuable, commercially viable products.

Dubai Culture and Arts Authority is also participating to raise awareness about the value of traditional crafts and their relevance in modern life. Their exhibit highlights how techniques like palm weaving vary by region and family, reflecting the diversity within Emirati heritage. By incorporating traditional patterns into

modern designs, they aim to connect younger generations with cultural identity.

Meanwhile, Al Khaznah Leathers, a sustainable tannery based in Abu Dhabi, bridges tradition and innovation. Founded in 2003 as a vision of the UAE’s Founding Father, the late Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan, the company produces chrome-free camel leather using eco-conscious methods. Its products range from handbags to aviation upholstery, and its training initiatives support the revival of traditional leatherwork in a sustainable, global context.



This new initiative will support mission-driven research led by core investigators from both institutions. The focus areas include advancing large language models, developing foundation models for reasoning, and exploring applications of AI in biology, health, and AI safety.

Professor Eric Xing, President and University Professor, MBZUAI, said, “Our partnerships and presence in France are critical to the continued growth and innovation of our research capabilities at MBZUAI and we’re excited to expand our relationship with École Polytechnique in support of these ef-

In February, MBZUAI signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with École Polytechnique (L’X) to foster collaboration on joint initiatives in education, research, and innovation in artificial intelligence. The agreement was formalised on the sidelines of the AI Action Summit in France, where Professor Xing delivered a keynote address on AI,

Science, and Society.

Building on this partnership, the two institutions signed the Scholars Exchange Program Agreement in April, enabling the exchange of students and researchers between MBZUAI and École Polytechnique.

Laura Chaubard, Director-General of École Polytechnique, said, “I’m delighted to be moving forward with our strategic research partnership with MBZUAI. The scientific synergies are numerous, in the fields of AI for health, safety, and environmental sustainability, as well as

The new initiative will support mission-driven research led by core investigators from both institutions. The focus areas include advancing large language models, developing foundation models for reasoning, and exploring applications of AI in biology, health, and AI safety

in large language models and foundation models for reasoning. I’m sure that these synergies will give rise to rich collaborations in the future.”

This strategic partnership represents a significant milestone in accelerating joint research efforts and supporting the next generation of researchers and innovators in the field of AI.

MBZUAI’s research ties with France are also supported by the growing presence of the MBZUAI France Lab in Paris. Among their achievements to date, researchers at this satellite lab have developed a family of open-source large language models (LLMs) called Atlas-Chat, focusing on the Moroccan Arabic dialect (Darija).

The team has released two language models: Atlas-Chat-2B, designed for efficient generation of fluent Darija text, and Atlas-Chat-9B, offering more nuanced, context-rich output for advanced tasks.

The France Lab will also be a focal point for MBZUAI’s soon-to-be-unveiled Institute of Foundation Models (IFM) — a bold, global initiative uniting AI talent across Abu Dhabi, Silicon Valley and Paris.

The France Lab will be one of three centres in each of these AI hubs designed to advance the next generation of foundation models and deliver their benefits to communities worldwide.
