The United Arab Emirates, via "Operation Chivalrous Knight 3", has delivered a new batch of emergency medical aid to health facilities in the Gaza Strip, in cooperation with the World Health Organisation (WHO).

The aid aims to alleviate the worsening health crisis in Gaza, marked by severe shortages of medicines and medical supplies.

Delivered through the Emirati field hospital in southern Gaza, the support included large quantities of essential medicines, urgent medical consumables, and specialised materials for paediatric care. The shipment also included 150 fully equipped medical beds and six field tents intended to establish temporary medical units to relieve pressure on hospitals that have sustained heavy damage or






