The forum, organised by the Ministry of Interior in cooperation with the Anti-Narcotics Council and the General Command of Abu Dhabi Police under the slogan "A Conscious Family... A Safe Society," was held on Al Maryah Island in Abu Dhabi. The event was attended by many community members, particularly youth and parents.

The forum, which began on 19 June and lasted for 11 days, witnessed the participation of a select group of specialists and experts from government and private agencies specialising in prevention and mental health, as well as religious scholars, national service recruits, university students, and social media influencers.

The Drug Prevention Forum included 320 discussion sessions addressing issues of community prevention and family cohesion, in addition to 920 counseling, psychological, social, and family sessions presented by specialists in the fields of mental health and family support. 33 awareness podcast episodes were also produced, and 8,800 certificates of participation were issued.

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The forum featured a range of interactive activities and innovative programmes, most notably: the Drug Prevention Council, the Future Leaders Council, psychological and social counseling sessions, in addition to discussion sessions and a prevention podcast. These included the "Mukafih" platform, launched by the Ministry of Interior, which aims to raise awareness among community members about the dangers and harms of drug abuse, detect early addiction cases, report crimes, and combat addiction by calling the toll-free number (80044).

The Abu Dhabi Police General Command also participated with the "Opportunity of Hope" platform, which provides addicts with the opportunity to seek treatment while maintaining complete privacy and confidentiality. The platform grants them exemption from punishment, helping them recover and return to

their normal lives as produc-

tive members of society.

recovering addicts and facilitating their reintegration into

The service covers all office activities that do not require approvals from other authorities, with a maximum of three employees allowed per licence. 
