

In a landmark decision during its virtual session on June 13, 2025, the global COSPAS-SARSAT organisation established a new international working group focused on artificial intelligence applications in satellite-aided search and rescue systems, with the UAE appointed as chair.


This development follows the successful series of international meetings hosted by Abu Dhabi from May 27 to June 5, 2025, where key advancements in space-based search and rescue technologies were discussed.

The UAE's National Guard Command, through the National Search and Rescue Centre, presented a comprehensive working paper that laid the foundation for the creation of this specialised committee.



The move was praised by representatives from 45 countries and major international organisations, including the International Telecommunication Union (ITU), the International Civil Aviation Organisation (ICAO), and the International Maritime Organisation (IMO), who acknowledged the UAE's leadership in advancing humanitarian rescue capabilities through cuttingedge technology.

Under the newly adopted framework, the UAE-led working group will coordinate technicollaboration among cal member states, develop AI-driven tools for mission control systems, and foster global readiness and responsiveness in search and rescue operations.




