It will process data using AI-powered Digital Twin models to produce dynamic, use-specific outputs and lead the Research & Development roadmap for new AI models and automation of map production workflows.

The mission, part of the ongoing “Operation Chivalrous Knight 3”, is carried out in cooperation with the Hashemite Kingdom of Jordan.

The UAE's intensive diplomatic efforts across the globe have succeeded in resuming the

Birds of Goodness operations, which had been suspended for nearly nine months due to war developments.

The UAE's determination to resume these operations stems from its vital role in alleviating the suffering of the brotherly Palestinian people.

Since its launch, the initiative has helped deliver around 3,750 tonnes of food and relief supplies, including essential food items and critical aid that meet the urgent needs of families affected by the dire and catastrophic humanitarian conditions in the Gaza Strip.
