THE UAE'S new initiative will explore ways to transfer ultra-secure data using quantum technology

UAE launches first quantum-secure communications testbed at ADGM

ABU DHABI / WAM

ADGM, ADGM Academy (ADGMA), Technology Innovation Institute (TII), Hub71, and ASPIRE — have jointly launched the nation's first Testbed for quantum-secure communications, marking a significant step towards future-proofing digital infrastructure. The initiative will explore ways to transfer ultra-secure data using quantum technology.

As part of the tie up, TII - the applied research pillar of Abu Dhabi's Advanced Technology Research Council (ATRC) — has deployed its proprietary Quantum Key Distribution (QKD) solution in ADGM, Abu Dhabi's international financial centre, to establish the first-of-its-kind test network in a commercial setting. The network acts as a "living lab" for highly secure, tamper-proof communications, in an era of increasing cyber threats and rising data privacy expectations. It enables stakeholders to interact

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directly with an operational QKD deployment, test use cases in a commercial setting, and build awareness of the solution's next-generation capabilities

ties and potential applications. Facilitated by ASPIRE, the innovation acceleration arm of ATRC, the initiative bridges advanced research with real-

world application and fosters collaboration across sectors.

For ADGM, the test network reflects a forward-looking approach to addressing cybersecurity risks and enhancing the resilience of digital infrastructure. By trialing quantum-safe communication technology, ADGM is helping to shape the technological infrastructure needed within the financial market, especially by digital asset businesses operating within the financial centre.

The network consists of a three-node QKD deployment, connecting three locations within ADGM's jurisdiction, with quantum devices installed at each site. The QKD devices supply encryption keys to an encrypted network layer, enabling secure communication across ADGM. Data travelling on this network would enjoy the ultimate level of forward security available today and be immune to retroactive attacks.

UAE carries out 80th airdrop of humanitarian aid under Birds of Goodness Operation to support Gaza

The latest airdrop included quantities of essential food supplies, prepared with the support of Emirati charitable organisations and institutions, to help meet the urgent needs of Gaza's residents amid dire humanitarian conditions.

Drydocks World wins contract for world's largest floating LNG facility off Mexico

DUBAI / WAM

Drydocks World, a DP World company, has been awarded a landmark Engineering, Procurement, and Construction (EPC) contract by AMIGO LNG for the world's largest Floating Liquefied Natural Gas (FLNG) liquefaction facility.

The breakthrough project includes the conversion of two LNG carriers into Floating Storage Units (FSUs) and the construction of two newbuild FLNG barges at Drydocks World's yard in Dubai. Once operational in the second half of 2028, the four-vessel facility will provide more than 4.2 mil-

lion tonnes per annum (MTPA) of liquefaction capacity, surpassing any existing floating LNG development worldwide.

AMIGO LNG is a joint venture between Texas-based Epsilon LNG LLC and Singapore-based LNG Alliance Pte Ltd. Located off Guaymas, Sonora on Mexico's west coast and supplied with natural gas from the US Permian Basin, the facility will expand Mexico's role in global energy supply by enabling direct LNG exports to meet growing demand in Asia and Latin America. Its strategic location shortens shipping distances to Asia compared with US Gulf terminals, cutting costs and



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emissions while opening a new LNG corridor at a critical time for global energy security.

Capt. Rado Antolovic, CEO, Drydocks World, said: "This contract represents a major milestone for Drydocks World and Dubai. With our expertise in complex offshore conversions and large-scale new builds, we are setting new global benchmarks for floating LNG solutions. At the same time, this project reinforces Dubai's position as a hub for advanced maritime engineering that powers global trade and the energy transition."

The EPC project will be executed using a modular build

strategy, enabling precision fabrication, seamless system integration and pre-commissioning in a controlled environment. This approach ensures rigorous quality assurance, shorter delivery schedules, reduced environmental impact, and reliable long-term performance. Dr Muthu Chezian, CEO of LNG Alliance Pte Ltd., said: "By partnering with Drydocks World on the world's largest FLNG facility, we are securing best-in-class quality, exceptional production capacity, and reliable long-term performance of this critical asset."

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Mleiha Park reveals Sharjah's thriving desert biodiversity

The park's unique attraction lies in its diverse biomes where eco-enthusiasts can encounter distinct terrains

SHARJAH / WAM

As the premier destination for eco-tourism within Sharjah, Mleiha National Park (MNP) stands as a notable conservation success story, giving visitors; both local and from afar; an opportunity to experience the majesty of the desert landscape, and come closer to nature.

Established by Emiri Decree under the leadership of His Highness Dr Sheikh Sultan bin Mohammed Al Qasimi, Supreme Council Member and Ruler of Sharjah, and developed and operated by the Sharjah Investment and Development Authority (Shurooq), this 34.2-square-kilometre protected area offers an unmatched destination in one of the Arabian Peninsula's most ecologically di-

verse settings. MNP is part of the Core Zone of the Faya Palaeolandscape, recently inscribed on the UNESCO World Heritage List, further confirming its global cultural value.

The park's unique attraction lies in its diverse biomes where eco-enthusiasts can encounter distinct terrains such as the iconic Barchan sand dunes, vast alluvial gravel plains, and rugged limestone outcrops. This topographical patchwork results in specialised micro-habitats, allowing a wide array of specially adapted flora and fauna to thrive side-by-side, and it's this ecological richness that adds to Mleiha's global appeal.

Over 100 distinct species have been documented within the park's boundaries, solidifying its status as a biodiversity hotspot including more than 20

indigenous plants and trees, such as the deep-rooted Ghaf tree, the thorny Umbrella Thorn

Acacia, the resilient Sodom's Apple, and the seasonal Arabian primrose; all playing important

roles within the ecosystem. Serving as lifelines to the park's inhabitants, they stabilise the shifting sands, retain moisture, and provide shelter, enabling other life to exist.

This botanical foundation supports a surprising diversity of wildlife with more than 11 mammal species navigating the terrain; most famously, the adaptable Arabian Red Fox and the graceful Sand Gazelle. Over 10 reptile species also call the park home, like the sand-burrowing Sandfish Skink and the cryptic Arabian Horned Viper; true masters of desert survival.

Avid birdwatchers also have the chance to spot 20+ species, from soaring raptors like Bonelli's Eagle to smaller residents like the iridescent Purple Sunbird, as well as many migratory visitors. Even the smaller denizens are crucial to the park's ecosystem with over 39 species of insects and arachnids, including the large Carpenter Bee, an essential pollinator for plants; and the Arabian Fat-Tailed Scorpion, a rarely seen predator keeping smaller insects and lizards in balance.


