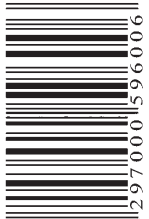

UAE President His Highness Sheikh Mohamed bin Zayed Al Nahyan received a phone call on Monday from the Rt Hon Sir Keir Starmer, Prime Minister of the United Kingdom. Fertiglobe reports revenues of \$758mn in Q3 2025

Fertiglobe on Monday announced its financial results for the three-month and nine-month periods ended 30 September 2025 (“Q3 2025” and “9M 2025”). In the third quarter, Fertiglobe reported strong revenues of \$758 million, reflecting a 53% increase year-over-year (Y-o-Y), while adjusted EBITDA increased 69% Y-o-Y to \$286 million, and adjusted net profit attributable to shareholders of \$134 million increased significantly versus \$28 million in the same period last year.
