## Abu Dhabi sees 42% surge in F&B business registrations

ABU DHABI / WAM

The Abu Dhabi Chamber of Commerce and Industry (ADCCI) has published a landmark report confirming that Abu Dhabi’s Food and Beverage (F&B) sector is entering a powerful high-growth phase, with the emirate recording 24,594 active F&B licenses as of September 2025, a 42.2 percent increase in new business registrations in the first half of 2025 compared with the same period in 2024, 40 percent year-on-year growth in 2024, and a sustained compound annual growth rate of 23.8 percent between 2019 and 2024.

The report, the first sectoral report issued under ADCCI’s 2025–2028 Strategy, also highlights expanding production capabilities, rising export potential and a strengthening innovation ecosystem that together position Abu Dhabi as one of the region’s most competitive and resilient food economies.

## UAE forecast to lead regional growth at 5.6 percent: FAB

ABU DHABI / WAM

First Abu Dhabi Bank (FAB) reported that 2026 marks a decisive shift in how capital must be allocated as growth diverges, policy recalibrates and global risk dynamics reset, according to its Global Investment Outlook 2026, titled “Shifting Currents: Recalibrating Capital Amid a Changing Global Economic Order.”



Global economic growth in 2026 is expected to be modest and uneven, with advanced economies expanding at approximately 1.5 percent, while emerging markets, particularly the GCC and Egypt, are expected to outperform, recording growth rates above 4 percent. The UAE is forecast to lead regional performance, with real GDP growth projected at around 5.6 percent, supported by diversification initiatives, structural reforms, and sustained investment activity, the report said.

The report assessed a global environment marked by economic transition, slower and more uneven monetary policy easing, shifting capital flows, and rising geopolitical and technological complexity.

You must submit a rejoinder to the case, along with all supporting documents, within a period not exceeding ten days from the date of publication, in order to consider the aforementioned case – in your capacity as the Defendant.

We hereby emphasize that in the event of non-attendance or failure to provide sufficient prior notice of absence for the scheduled session, the expertise proceedings shall continue in accordance with the applicable legal procedures.
