

## UAE forecast to lead regional growth at 5.6 percent: FAB

ABU DHABI / WAM

First Abu Dhabi Bank (FAB) reported that 2026 marks a decisive shift in how capital must be allocated as growth diverges, policy recalibrates and global risk dynamics reset, according to its Global Investment Outlook 2026, titled "Shifting Currents: Recalibrating Capital Amid a Changing Global Economic Order."

Global economic growth in 2026 is expected to be modest and uneven, with advanced economies expanding at approximately 1.5 percent, while emerging markets, particularly the GCC and Egypt, are expected to outperform, recording growth rates above 4 percent. The UAE is forecast to lead regional performance, with real GDP growth projected at around 5.6 percent, supported by diversification initiatives, structural reforms, and sustained investment activity, the report said.

The report assessed a global environment marked by economic transition, slower and more uneven monetary policy easing, shifting capital flows, and rising geopolitical and technological complexity.
