Mubadala Energy completes acquisition from Eni of 15% interest in Egypt's Nargis concession

Mubadala Energy, the Abu Dhabi headquartered international energy company, announced that it has completed the acquisition from Eni of a 15 percent participating interest in the Nargis Offshore Area (Nargis) concession, an offshore exploration block in Egypt.

In the concession, Eni now holds a 30 percent of the Contractor interest through its subsidiary, IOEC. The concession is operated by Chevron, with a 45 percent Contractor interest, with the remaining 10 percent interest



owned by Tharwa Petroleum Company. The concession is operated in partnership with the Egyptian Natural Gas Holding Company (EGAS), with the contractor group holding 50 percent and EGAS holding 50 percent.


