UAE air defences engage 12 ballistic missiles, 2 cruise missiles, 19 UAVs

ABU DHABI / WAM

The UAE Ministry of Defence announced that on Monday, April 6, 2026, the country's air defences intercepted 12 ballistic missiles, 2 cruise missiles, and 19 UAVs launched from Iran.

Since the start of the blatant Iranian attacks, UAE air defences

have intercepted a total of 519 ballistic missiles, 26 cruise missiles, and 2,210 drones.

These attacks resulted in four injuries ranging from minor to moderate and severe, bringing the total number of injuries to 221. The injured are of various nationalities, including Emirati, Egyptian, Sudanese, Ethiopian, Filipino, Pak-

istani, Iranian, Indian, Bangladeshi, Sri Lankan, Azerbaijani, Yemeni, Ugandan, Eritrean, Lebanese, Afghan, Bahraini, Comorian, Turkish, Iraqi, Nepalese, Nigerian, Omani, Jordanian, Palestinian, Ghanaian, Indonesian, Swedish, Tunisian, Moroccan, and Russian.

No deaths or martyrdom cases were recorded in the past five.

Since the beginning of the attacks, the total number of martyrs stands at two, in addition to one Moroccan civilian contractor working with the UAE Armed Forces.

The total number of civilian fatalities has reached 10, from the following nationalities: Pakistani, Nepalese, Bangladeshi, Palestinian, Indian, and Egyptian.

Noatum Ports Safaga Terminal - Egypt receives STS, RTG cranes

The new terminal forms part of AD Ports' broader strategy to develop and operate high-performance port assets across trade corridors

Noatum Ports, the international ports operating arm of AD Ports Group, today confirmed the delivery of three new ship-to-shore (STS) and six rubber tyred gantry (RTG) cranes to its new multipurpose terminal in Safaga, Egypt, marking a crucial step ahead of the opening later this year of a major new commercial maritime gateway on the Red Sea in southern Egypt.

The Super Post-Panamax-class cranes made by Shanghai Zhenhua Heavy Industries Co. Ltd (ZPMC), a leading global manufacturer of industrial cranes, were successfully delivered following ocean transport from China, confirming the commencement of phased operational activities at Noatum Ports - Safaga Terminal, subsequent to the completion of major infrastructure development works.

Strategically located on Egypt's Red Sea coast, Noatum Ports - Safaga Terminal is poised to be the first internationally operated port terminal in the Upper Egypt region of southern Egypt, serving as a key gateway for the region and strengthening connectiv-

deep draft capabilities, and best-in-class port operations, in addition to playing a central role in enabling industrial development across Upper Egypt and the wider Red Sea region, including container trade, project cargo for industrial and green energy infrastructure, and mining logistics.

Mohammed Al Tamimi, Chief Executive Officer of Noatum Ports, said, "The arrival of the STS and RTG cranes marks a key operational milestone for Noatum Ports - Safaga Terminal, ahead of its opening later this year as a major gateway for economic development in southern Egypt. This milestone signals the transition from development to operations at a strategically important location. The terminal will serve as a key Red Sea gateway, supporting global trade flows and contributing to Egypt's economic growth."

Noatum Ports - Safaga Terminal will span approximately 810,000 m², featuring a 1,000-metre quay wall designed to handle up to 450,000 TEUs, alongside 5 million tonnes of dry bulk and general cargo, 1 million tonnes of liquid bulk, and 50,000 CEUs of Ro-Ro cargo.

This accreditation is among the most prominent international recognitions in

EPAA discovers 4 new spider species in UAE

The milestone emphasises the richness of UAE's natural environments

In a new scientific milestone highlighting Sharjah's leadership in environmental research and biodiversity, the Environment and Protected Areas Authority (EPAA) in Sharjah has announced the discovery of four spider species across various mountainous and valley ecosystems in the UAE.

This milestone emphasises the richness of UAE's natural environments and opens new pathways for understanding the delicate ecological balance that characterises the UAE's diverse habitats.

RICH ECOSYSTEMS REVEAL NEW SCIENTIFIC DISCOVERIES

The discovery results from the dedicated efforts of the research team at the Al Dhaid Wildlife Museum in Al Dhaid, led by Professor Dr Mostafa Sharaf, Professor of Entomology at EPAA, with the participation of researchers Maryam Al Qaydi, Meera Al Tunaiji, Latifa Sultan, and Latifa Rashid, and under the supervision of Ms Khafiya Al Ketbi, the museum's director.

Two of the new species were collected in Wadi Shees, a third in Wadi Al Helo, and the fourth in Masafi, highlighting the exceptional biodiversity within the UAE's mountainous and valley landscapes, many of which continue to host undiscovered species.

Aisha Rashid Deemas, Chairperson of the Environment and Protected Areas Authority in Sharjah (EPAA), stressed that this achievement underscores EPAA's commitment to prioritising scientific research in environmental

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protection.

She stated: "This significant scientific discovery represents a valuable addition to the UAE's growing body of environmental and biodiversity research. It also reflects the depth and richness of the ecosystems found across Sharjah. Documenting species new to science goes beyond academic value; it strengthens our understanding of ecological systems and supports the development of effective policies for biodiversity conservation and sustainable natural resource management."

She said: "At EPAA, we re-

main committed to investing in scientific research and strengthening international collaborations, further positioning Sharjah as a regional and global hub for environmental studies."

One of the newly discovered species was named *Leptopilos hajarensis* (Hajar Mountain Spider), in reference to the Hajar Mountains, while another was named *Prodidomus emiratensis* (Emirates Spider) to honour the UAE. The remaining two species were named based on their distinct morphological characteristics.

Additionally, the research

team documented eight genera and four species of spiders for the first time in the UAE, further highlighting the country's rich and largely unexplored biodiversity.

The findings were published in volume no. 1276 of the scientific journal ZooKeys as part of an international research collaboration involving scientists from the UAE, Russia, Finland, Hungary, and South Africa, highlighting the growing global presence of Sharjah and the UAE in environmental and biodiversity research.

EPAA reaffirmed that these discoveries are part of ongoing research inventories, as the UAE's mountains, valleys, and deserts continue to hold promising scientific treasures, highlighting the importance of sustained field research and exploration.

UAE joins Svalbard Treaty in Norway to support Arctic Research & Cooperation

The UAE has officially joined the Svalbard Treaty, following Federal Decree No. 125 of 2025. This step strengthens the country's role in polar science and international cooperation and reflects its commitment to protecting some of the world's most climate-sensitive regions.

Svalbard is a Norwegian archipelago located in the far Northern Hemisphere of Earth, midway between mainland Norway and the North Pole. It is known for its unique Arctic environment, its international scientific research community, and the world-renowned Global Seed Vault, which preserves millions of seeds as a safeguard for global food security.

The Svalbard Treaty promotes peaceful cooperation and responsible access in this Arctic region. By joining the treaty, the UAE builds on its existing engagement in the Antarctic Treaty System and expands its scientific contribution into the Northern Hemisphere of the Earth, complementing its work in Antarctica in the Southern Hemisphere.

This accession supports the objectives of the Emirates Polar Programme (EPP), which seeks to strengthen the UAE's role in polar sciences and advance research across both regions: Arctic and Antarctic. Membership in the Svalbard Treaty can facilitate fieldwork by UAE researchers in Ny-Ålesund, Svalbard; one of the world's northernmost international research communities

The Svalbard Treaty promotes peaceful cooperation and responsible access in the Arctic region. By joining the treaty, the UAE builds on its existing engagement in the Antarctic Treaty System and expands its scientific contribution into the Northern Hemisphere of the Earth, complementing its work in Antarctica in the Southern Hemisphere

where scientists from more than ten countries collaborate on polar and atmospheric studies.

Speaking on this milestone, Mariam Almheiri Head of the International Affairs Office at the Presidential Court and Chair of the Emirates Polar Programme said: "Joining the Svalbard Treaty demonstrates the UAE's steadfast commitment to international collaboration and scientific advancement."

"This agreement opens an important and exciting chapter for the UAE's engagement in Arctic science, enabling us to contribute meaningfully to global research efforts. It also strengthens opportunities for deeper scientific cooperation and participation in joint Arctic expeditions alongside leading nations to help safeguard some of the world's most fragile ecosystems."

Arada launches fifth phase of Sharjah's Masaar 3

Arada has launched sales at Layan, the fifth phase of its landmark Masaar 3 forest community in Sharjah.
