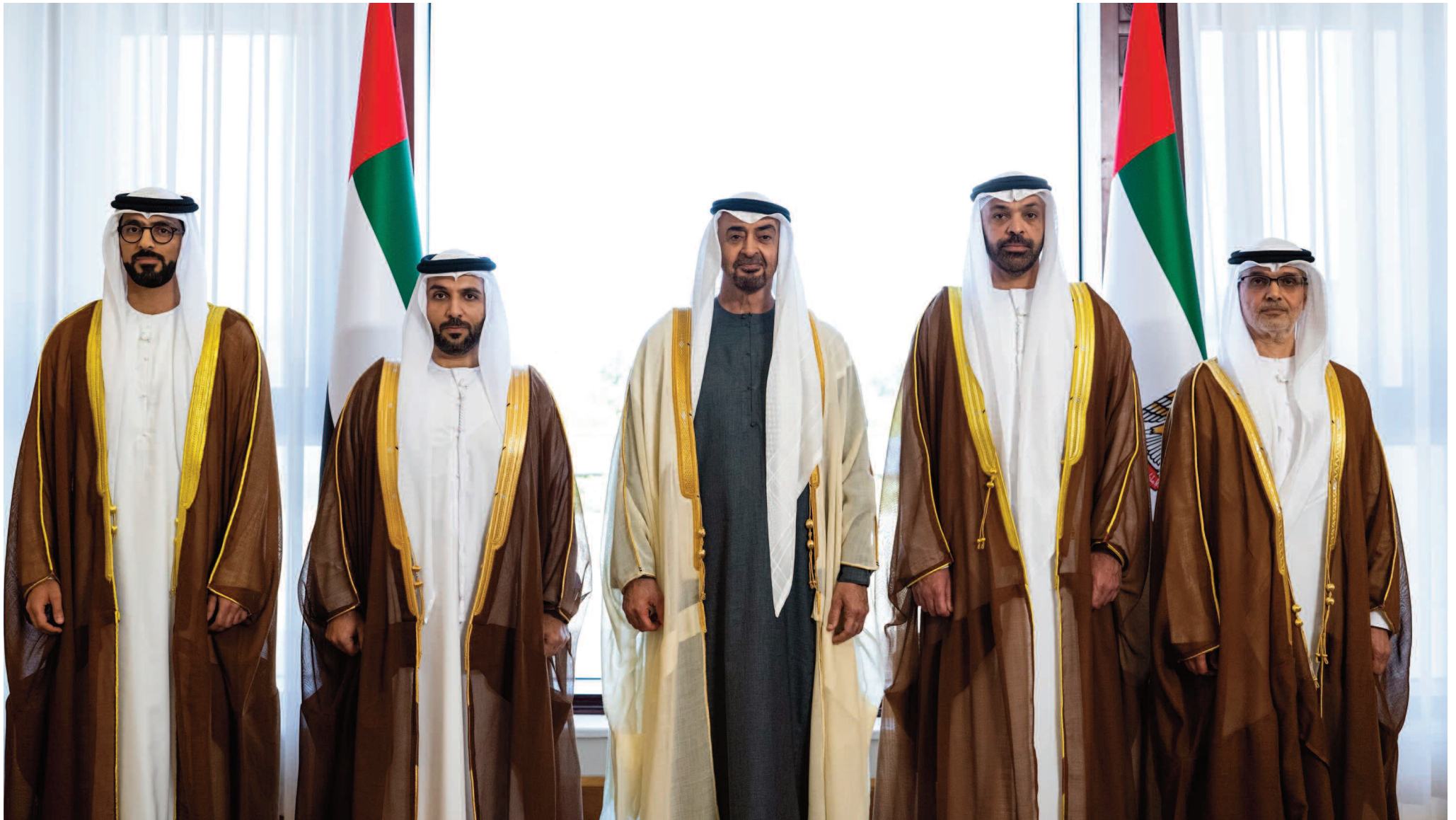

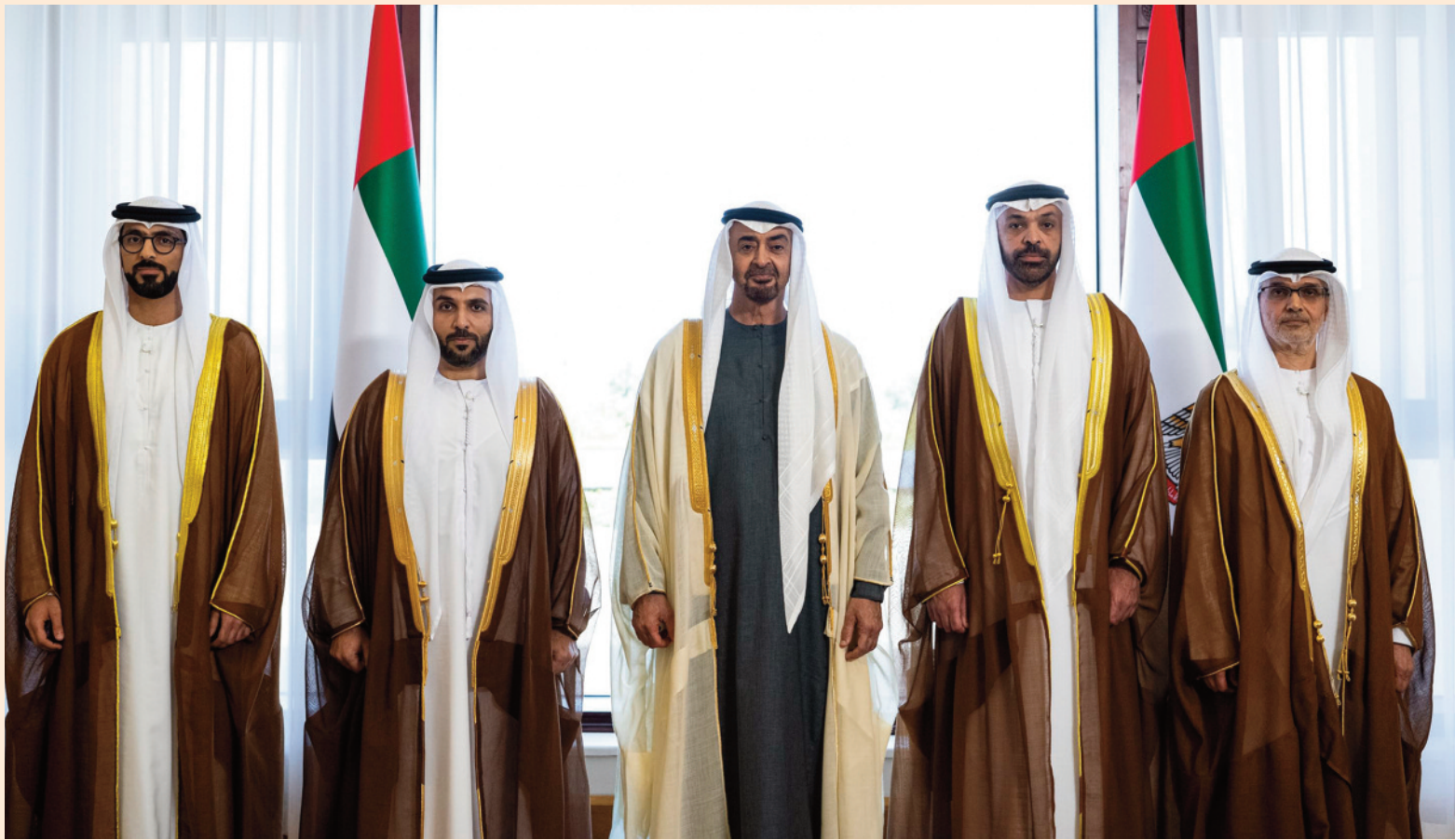

Saqr Ghobash, German MP discuss regional escalation

Saqr Ghobash, Speaker of the Federal National Council (FNC), met with Alexander Radwan, Member of the Committee on Foreign Affairs and the Committee on European Affairs of the German Bundestag and head of the German delegation, on the sidelines of the 152nd Assembly of the Inter-Parliamentary Union (IPU), held in Istanbul.

The two sides reviewed developments in the regional situation, particularly in light of the recent escalation and its repercussions for regional and international security and stability.

Saqr Ghobash stressed that the attacks targeting the UAE cannot be justified under any circumstances, noting that the UAE had clearly stated it would not allow its territory, airspace, or waters to be used to launch any attacks, in line with its firm principles of respecting state sovereignty and refraining from involvement in conflicts.

He outlined the scale of the threats faced by the country, noting that more than 95 % of the attacks

targeting its territory had been successfully intercepted, thanks to the efficiency and readiness of its

air defence systems, reflecting the UAE's capability to safeguard its security and stability.

He further pointed to Iran's conduct in the region over more than 47 years, characterised by interference in the internal affairs of states and support for proxies across several regional arenas, raising serious questions about the prospects for co-existence with such an approach in the future.

He also questioned how to deal with a system that continues to pursue these policies and what could happen if it were to acquire nuclear capabilities.

Ghobash warned of the dangers posed by threats to close the Strait of Hormuz, emphasising that such actions would not only affect countries in the region but would also impact the global economy, international supply chains, and maritime navigation.

In this context, he underscored that the UAE, in addressing these circumstances, has adhered to a comprehensive humanitarian approach, working to provide various forms of support and care to all communities residing within its territory.

General of the Sharjah Council for Higher Education and Scientific Research; Counselor Yousef Hassan Al Ali, Director of the Experts and Consultants Office at the Legal Department; Counselor Saleh Mohammed Al Zaabi, Director of the Emiri Legal Affairs Office at the Legal Department; and Aisha Mohammed Hazim Al Suwaidi, Director of the Legislation Department at the Legal Department. Dr Mansour Mohammed bin Nassar explained that the idea of establishing the University of Arts arose from the continued success of the Sharjah Academy of Performing Arts. 7th TRENDS Strategic Dialogue recommends strengthening African regional cooperation

Participants in the Seventh Strategic Dialogue, organised by TRENDS Research & Advisory through its South Africa office, titled The War in the Middle East: How Sub-Saharan Africa Sees the Crisis, recommended strengthening regional cooperation within Africa as a central tool to enhance collective capacity to absorb external shocks and coordinate positions in international forums related to security and development.

They emphasised the need to adopt a proactive approach to managing geopolitical risks by integrating major regional transformations into economic and security planning policies in Sub-Saharan African countries, rather than treating them as emergency crises.

They also stressed the importance of diversifying international partnerships to reduce reliance on single centers of influence and strengthen African countries' ability to negotiate within a more balanced and flexible global environment.

They further emphasised the need to invest in economic resilience, particularly in the energy and food sectors, by developing more stable local and regional supply chains and reducing exposure to volatile external markets. In addition, they called for a more effective African role in international discussions on regional security to ensure that global decisions reflect development and economic justice rather than solely traditional power balances.

On International Day for Monuments and Sites, observed on 18th April, Al Faya World Heritage Site in the Emirate of Sharjah stands out as one of the most important archaeological sites in the world.

The site, inscribed on the World Heritage List in 2025, preserves evidence documenting human presence in the region for over 200,000 years, making it one of the oldest and longest-lasting integrated records of early human existence in a desert



environment and a key reference for understanding early migration routes and human dispersal out of Africa.

worth AED 2 million running from 2026 to 2028, which is currently undergoing scientific evaluation with the participation of leading regional and international academic institutions. These efforts enhance the UAE's standing in heritage science and archaeological research.

UNESCO's World Heritage List includes more than 1,100 sites, 97 of which are in the Arab region, spread across more than 160 countries worldwide. These sites encompass outstanding cultural and natural sites of exceptional universal value.


