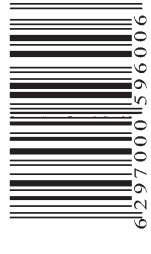

Abu Dhabi's non-oil foreign trade records 36 percent growth in 2025

It reflects the emirate's leading position as one of the world's fastest-growing economies in external trade, driven by expanding commercial activity

Statistics released by Abu Dhabi Customs reveal a significant rise in the emirate's non-oil foreign trade in 2025, increasing by 36 percent to exceed AED415.4 billion, compared with approximately AED306 billion in 2024.

This growth reflects Abu Dhabi's leading position as one of the world's fastest-growing economies in external trade, driven by expanding commercial activity and strengthened economic partnerships with global markets.

Non-oil exports recorded a notable increase of 63 percent in 2025, reaching AED175.4 billion, up from AED107.8 billion in 2024. Imports rose by 22 percent to AED170.4 billion



Amid an increasingly complex global environment, Abu Dhabi continues to ensure fluid trade movement, reduce friction across supply chains, and operate with consistency

in 2025, compared with AED140.2 billion in 2024.

Re-exports also saw strong growth, increasing by 20 percent to AED70 billion in 2025, up from AED58 billion in 2024.

The results demonstrate Abu Dhabi's economic resilience

and the continued progress of economic diversification. They also highlight the efficiency of the emirate's infrastructure in supporting trade and business, further strengthening its status as a regional and global hub for trade and logistics.

ADIB maintains strong momentum in Q1, with net profit up 8% y-o-y to AED2.1b

Abu Dhabi Islamic Bank (ADIB) sustained its positive momentum in Q1 2026, delivering strong financial performance across the group.

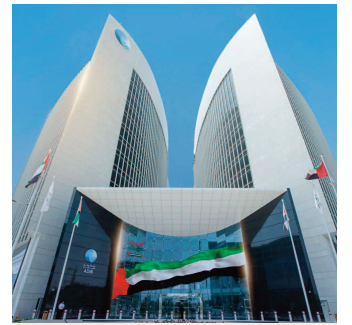
According to financial results, the bank recorded a year-on-year increase of 8%, with net profit before tax reaching AED 2.1 billion in the first quarter, up 2.3% compared to the previous quarter.

The earnings growth reflects healthy balance sheet expansion and continued customer acquisition across key segments, with 66,000 new customers acquired during the period.

Net profit after tax for Q1 2026 stood at AED 1.8 billion, representing an increase of 7% compared to Q1 2025.

Revenue for the first quarter of 2026 reached AED 3.2 billion compared to AED 2.9 billion for the corresponding period of 2025, representing a year-on-year growth of 12%.

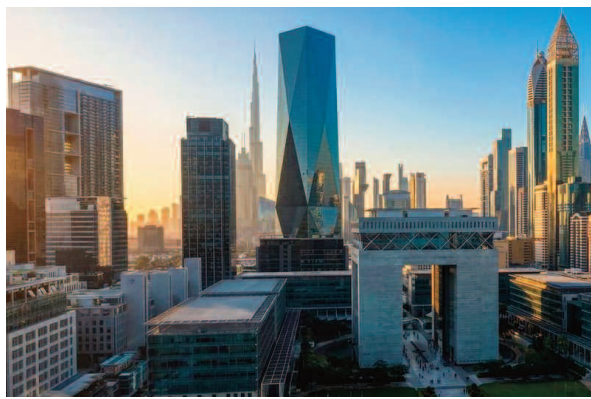

775 new companies established their regional presence in DIFC during the first three months of 2026, reflecting the Centre's prominence for finance, business, and innovation. This represents a 62% increase on the same period in 2025, when 478 companies set up in the Centre. Performance was particularly strong in March when compared to the prior year, with 258 companies establishing in March 2026, up from 162 in March 2025, reflecting 59% year-on-year growth.

TECOM Group reports AED403m net profit in Q1

TECOM Group PJSC announced its financial results for the first quarter of 2026, delivering revenues of AED755 million, representing an 11 percent year-on-year (YoY) increase, alongside a 12 percent increase in recurring net profit to AED403 million, compared to AED361 million in Q1 2025.

EBITDA increased 13 percent YoY to AED610 million, delivering an 81 percent margin, compared to 79 percent in Q1 2025, supported by higher occupancy, rental rate optimisation, and disciplined cost management.

The Group reported a resilient first quarter financial performance in 2026, driven by strong demand across its specialised business districts and continued growth in its commercial and industrial portfolios. Strategic investments, high occupancy rates, and solid customer retention, together with improved rental rates and disciplined cost management, have contributed to enhancing the Group's profitability.

Abdulla Belhoul, CEO of TECOM Group, said, "The UAE and Dubai economies continue to demonstrate remarkable strength and resilience, driven by a proven ability to adapt swiftly to market dynamics. He added that the commercial and industrial portfolios remained highly resilient, with occupancy at 98 percent across both segments. Customer retention remained strong at 94 percent for the commercial portfolio and 99 percent for the industrial portfolio. Funds from Operations (FFO) increased 14 percent YoY to AED549 million, demonstrating the high quality and resilience of the Group's revenue streams, supported by a strong and diversified customer base and efficient

Dubai Aerospace Enterprise reports \$102.2m net profit in Q1

DAE's revenue rose by 15% to a record \$455.5 million, compared to \$395.9 million in the first quarter of 2025

Dubai Aerospace Enterprise (DAE) Ltd announced on Wednesday a net profit of US\$102.2 million for the first quarter of 2026, marking a 19.11 percent increase compared to US\$85.8 million recorded during the same period in 2025.

The company reported profit before tax of \$120.4 million, compared to \$101.2 million in the corresponding period last year.

Revenue rose by 15 percent to a record \$455.5 million, compared to \$395.9 million in the first quarter of 2025.

Operating profit reached \$243.1 million, compared to \$201.4 million, while net finance costs stood at \$122.7



DAE's stellar financial performance over the last five years, combined with its enhanced franchise scale, led to an upgrade of senior unsecured debt ratings to 'A-' by KBRA, a global full-service rating agency, said Firoz Tarapore, CEO of DAE —WAM

million. Income tax expenses amounted to \$18.2 million during the period.

Operating cash flow totalled \$296.3 million, compared to \$344.7 million in the same period last year.

The pre-tax profit margin increased to 26.4 percent from 25.6 percent, while the pre-tax return on equity remained stable at 13 percent.
