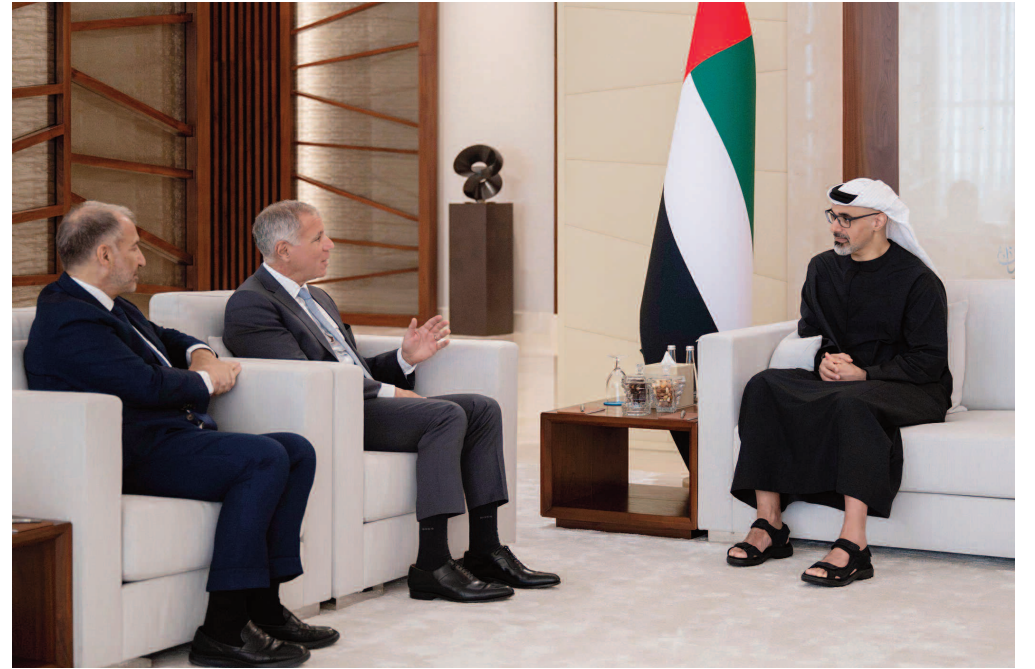

UAE strongly condemns renewed unprovoked Iranian aggression using missiles, drones

The United Arab Emirates has condemned in the strongest terms the renewed terrorist, unprovoked Iranian attacks targeting civilian sites and facilities in the country using missiles and drones, which resulted in the injury of three Indian nationals.

In a statement, the Ministry of Foreign Affairs (MoFA) affirmed that these attacks constitute a dangerous escalation, an unacceptable act of aggression, and a direct threat to the UAE's security, stability, and territorial integrity, in violation of the principles of international law and the Charter of the United Nations.

The UAE emphasised that it will not tolerate any threat to its security and sovereignty under any circumstances, and that it reserves its full and legitimate right to respond to these unprovoked attacks in a manner that ensures the protection of its sovereignty, national security, territorial integrity, and the safety of its citizens, residents, and visitors, in accordance with international law.

UAE strongly condemns targeting of ADNOC national carrier while transiting Strait of Hormuz

The United Arab Emirates has strongly condemned and denounced the Iranian terrorist attack involving two drones that targeted a national carrier affiliated with ADNOC as it transited through the Strait of Hormuz, with no injuries reported.

In a statement, the Ministry

of Foreign Affairs (MoFA) underscored that this attack constitutes a flagrant violation of UN Security Council resolution 2817, which affirmed the importance of freedom of navigation, and rejected the targeting of commercial vessels or the obstruction of international maritime routes.

Ethiad Rail transports 1.8mn tonnes of sulphur, prepares for phased passenger launch

Ethiad Rail network represents an integrated national model aligned with the Make it in the Emirates vision: Official

Ethiad Rail transported 1.8 million tonnes of sulphur in 2026, alongside more than 4 million tonnes of aggregates and over 129,000 containers, reflecting continued growth and operational efficiency, according to Adhraa Almansoori, Director of Public Policy and Sustainability at Ethiad Rail.

Almansoori told *Emirates News Agency* (WAM), on the sidelines of Make it in the Emirates 2026, that the company has supported sustainability goals by eliminating more than 340,000 truck journeys on

roads and reducing carbon emissions by between 70 percent and 80 percent per trip. She noted that rail freight services provide a comprehensive, cost-effective and reliable logistics solution across the UAE.

She added that freight services on the national railway network are directly connected to Khalifa Port, Jebel Ali Port and the Industrial City of Abu Dhabi (ICAD), as well as key logistics hubs through 11 stations, including four major ports. Each freight train can carry the equivalent load of 300 heavy trucks, enhancing efficiency in transporting large

volumes of goods in a single journey.

She noted that current clients include ADNOC for sulphur transport, Stevin Rock for aggregates, and Borouge for petrochemicals. Freight trains operate on scheduled timetables and dedicated corridors, ensuring continuity of operations without disruption from traffic congestion or road incidents.

Almansoori confirmed that Ethiad Rail Freight, responsible for cargo operations, has recorded consistent growth since the launch of freight services in February 2023, contributing to trade flows and

supply chain efficiency in line with the growing needs of the industrial sector.

Regarding passenger services, she said operations will be introduced in gradual, carefully planned phases, with the first phase set to begin in 2026, ensuring the highest standards of safety, reliability and efficiency in line with global best practices.

She explained that the initial phase will connect Abu Dhabi and Dubai, extending to Fujairah on the east coast, noting that route selection was based on criteria including population density, demand levels and

connectivity priorities between the emirates.

On the company's participation in Make it in the Emirates 2026, Al Mansoori said Ethiad Rail is taking part for the second consecutive year, reflecting the importance of the event in supporting industrial growth,

DXB sustains global connectivity through regional disruption

Following the lifting of all precautionary restrictions on UAE airspace, Dubai Airports has entered the next phase of recovery operations

DUBAI / WAM

Dubai International (DXB) continued to sustain global connectivity through a period of regional disruption that significantly constrained airspace capacity and flight schedules across a critical aviation corridor. With airspace within the UAE now fully restored, Dubai Airports is moving decisively to scale up operations, increasing flight movements in line with available regional routing capacity.

Since the situation began on 28th February and intensified through March, Dubai's airports remained operational despite constraints, supporting the safe movement of 6 million guests, over 32,000 aircraft movements, and 213,000 tonnes of essential cargo as of 30th April.

Operations at DXB were maintained under continuously changing conditions, with schedules, passenger flows, and ground handling aligned to available airspace. Coordinated decision-making across the airport ecosystem enabled the airport to sustain safe and consistent service continuity, despite severe constraints.

Following the lifting of all precautionary restrictions on UAE airspace, Dubai Airports has entered the next phase of recovery operations, ramping up daily flight movements and enabling airlines to progressively restore schedules. Capacity is now primarily aligned to the availability of regional flight paths outside of the UAE,

with ongoing coordination to optimise flows across neighbouring airspace. This was supported by close collaboration across the oneDXB community, including international airlines led by home base carriers Emirates and flydubai, service partners and control authorities.

Working in alignment, the airport community ensured the ongoing movement of passengers and cargo, while enabling a rapid and coordinated increase in operations as capacity became available. Paul Griffiths, CEO of

Dubai Airports, said, “The extraordinary events of the past few weeks are unprecedented for any major airport hub such as DXB.

International transfer traffic through the Middle East region accounts for a major share of the global air travel market, with 22.4 million annual passenger journeys flowing through DXB, representing one third of the transfer traffic across the region's hubs.

Maintaining the smooth operation of DXB is therefore critical to keep global jour-

neys moving. Our focus has been on keeping operations safe and consistent for our customers through close co-ordination and rapid decision-making across the entire airport community and beyond, while ensuring the system remains ready to respond swiftly as conditions improve.”

He added, “Our collective response to these challenges has sharpened our ability to adapt at pace. That readiness will enable us to accommodate returning demand as capacity is restored, reinforcing DXB's role as a leading global hub, even as some regional routing constraints remain.”

Dubai's role as a global hub is closely linked to the international transfer market. Of the 99.3 million transferring passengers whose journeys could route through the Middle East, the region captures around 70 percent, with DXB handling 32 percent of that traffic.

UAE welcomes FAO decision to condemn Iran over disruption to food, agriculture supply chains

The UAE welcomed the decision adopted by the Food and Agriculture Organisation (FAO) Council, at a Special Session of the Council, as part of a UAE-led initiative, together with GCC Member States and partners, which included a condemnation of Iran's actions that jeopardise food security. The decision addresses the implications for global food security and agriculture arising from Iran's actions in the Strait of Hormuz as well as its targeting of vital infrastructure, including energy facilities, desalination plants, and food-related facilities, which has led to the disruption of supply chains in the Gulf region, including key maritime routes.

The decision was led by the UAE, together with GCC countries, Jordan, Egypt, Lebanon, and Morocco, and was adopted by consensus.

The UAE expresses its appreciation to FAO Member States, and in particular all Council members for their constructive engagement in advancing this initiative within the FAO's mandate.

The decision underscores the urgent need to prevent the politicisation of food and agriculture supply chains and to safeguard global food security, particularly for vulnerable and food-import dependent countries. It further emphasizes that secure and predictable flows of food,

fertilizers, and agricultural inputs — supported by open and well-functioning trade routes — are essential to global market stability and the protection of affected populations.

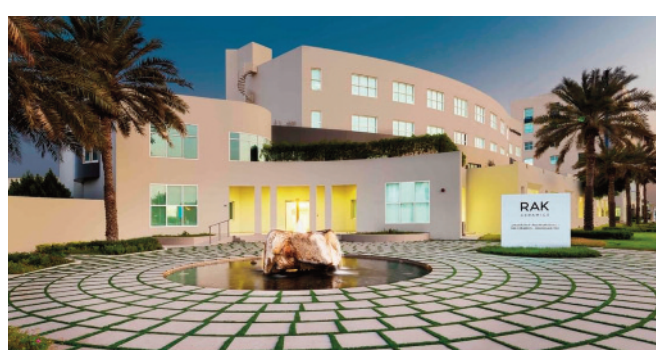

Mira Aerospace to launch upgraded HAPS platform by year-end

Khaled Almarzooqi, Chief Executive Officer of Mira Aerospace, a subsidiary of Space42, said manufacturing advanced high-altitude platforms within the UAE is a key pillar in strengthening the presence of national industries in space, aviation technologies, communications and surveillance.

He revealed in a statement to *Emirates News Agency* (WAM), on the sidelines of the first day of Make it in the Emirates 2026, that the company is set to launch an upgraded version of its high-altitude platform system (HAPS) before the end of the year, with a wingspan of 30 metres.

He said Mira Aerospace's participation in the event comes for the second consecutive year, as a company that develops and produces advanced technologies within the UAE, particularly HAPS platforms manufactured with Emirati intellectual property.

Al Marzooqi explained that the HAPS is a solar-powered unmanned aerial vehicle with a current wingspan of around 18 metres, capable of flying at altitudes between 14 and 16 kilometres for durations exceeding one week, with the potential to extend to several weeks due to its reliance on solar panels for clean en-

ergy generation.

He added that the company has successfully conducted test flights lasting one week, noting that extending beyond this duration has so far been limited by regulatory constraints related to stratospheric operations rather than technical limitations. He said the company is working with relevant authorities inside and outside the UAE to obtain approvals for longer-duration tests.

He emphasised that Mira Aerospace holds the intellectual property for this technology, which is manufactured locally at a facility in Al Dhafra region, reflecting the objectives of Make it in the Emirates in localising advanced industries, alongside other products developed by the company and Space42 within the country.
