Sharjah Chamber registers 30,000 memberships in H1

The Sharjah Chamber of Commerce and Industry (SCCI) reported an impressive surge in registered memberships in the first half of 2026, recording nearly 30,000 new memberships and membership renewals.

competitive regional and international trading centre.
