IFHC signs agreements with Ekthar at ADIHEX 2026

They will support priorities spanning species conservation, biodiversity

ABU DHABI / WAM

The International Fund for Houbara Conservation (IFHC) and Ekthar Wildlife Development have signed more than 11 strategic agreements during the 23rd Abu Dhabi International Hunting and Equestrian Exhibition (ADIHEX).

The portfolio includes agreements between IFHC and Reneco, an operating entity of Ekthar, as well as agreements with national and international partners, strengthening the framework of cooperation supporting the Sheikh Zayed Houbara Conservation Programme.

The agreements bring together government entities, academic and research institutions, conservation organisations and other strategic partners. Collectively, they will support priorities spanning species conservation and biodiversity, scientific research and innovation, knowledge exchange and capacity building, cultural heritage and institutional cooperation.

The portfolio reflects the complementary roles of IFHC and Ekthar within the Sheikh Zayed Houbara Conservation Programme. IFHC leads the Programme's strategic conservation priorities, international advocacy, education and engagement, while Ekthar provides the scientific, technical and operational capabilities that support their delivery.

Mohamed Almotawa AlDhaheeri, Acting Director-General of the International Fund for Houbara Conservation, said, "The long-term success of conservation depends on sustained cooperation across institutions, sectors and borders. These agreements extend the partnership ecosystem supporting the Sheikh Zayed Houbara Conservation Programme and create new opportunities to exchange knowledge, develop capabilities and translate our shared commitments into meaningful action."

"They also build on a conservation legacy that began with the vision of the late Sheikh Zayed bin Sultan Al Nahyan and continues to evolve through science, innovation and international co-

operation. By bringing together partners with complementary expertise, we can strengthen the Programme's contribution to the future of the houbara and the ecosystems it shares."

IFHC also signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Emirates Falconers' Club to advance houbara conservation while supporting the sustainable preservation of falconry heritage in the UAE.

The two organisations will cooperate on research and studies related to the houbara, capacity-building and specialist training, and awareness programmes for falconers and the wider community. The partnership will also support efforts to combat illegal hunting and trafficking in birds, strengthen the collection and analysis of scientific data and improve the exchange of information between the two organisations.

Abu Dhabi Nature Academy also signed a Memorandum of Understanding with the Environment Agency –

Abu Dhabi (EAD) to explore cooperation across science-led conservation priorities.

Ekthar also signed a five-year Memorandum of Understanding with Hikvision DMCC Abu Dhabi to explore how advanced digital technologies can support wildlife monitoring, habitat protection, biodiversity measurement and smart eco-tourism management.

The partnership will explore the use of AI-enabled cameras, smart thermal sensors and machine-learning models for non-intrusive wildlife tracking, automated species identification and population counts.

Tate Wu, President, Hikvision UAE BU, said, "The UAE is setting the pace on protecting its natural environment, and Hikvision is proud to be part of that. Signing this five-year partnership with Ekthar is a real milestone for us. Together, we're bringing conservation expertise and AIoT technology into the field to give conservationists smarter, non-intrusive ways to monitor wildlife and protect the habitats they depend on. UAE building integrated, data-driven air quality system: Minister of Climate Change

DUBAI / WAM

Dr. Amna bint Abdullah Al Dahak, Minister of Climate Change and Environment, affirmed that the UAE joins the international community in marking the seventh International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies and in calling for stronger cooperation and practical solutions that improve air quality while advancing climate action and economic resilience.

"This year's International Day of Clean Air for Blue Skies will focus on the fact that clean air is not only an environmental objective, but an investment in the community, stronger economy and shared prosperity. Air pollution and climate change are caused by the same sources, and integrated action gives us an opportunity to deliver benefits across climate and sustainable development." "In the UAE, enhancing air quality is a strategic national priority. Guided by our leadership's vision, the National Air Quality Agenda 2031 provides a clear framework for aligning federal and local government entities and the private sector around three pillars, monitoring, mitigation and management with the aim of ensuring the well-being of the community."

"It addresses outdoor and indoor air quality, ambient odour and ambient noise, supported by federal environmental legislation and regulatory requirements that strengthen the prevention, control and management of emissions."

She added, "Turning policy into measurable action requires reliable, accessible and well-integrated data. The UAE's National Air Quality Platform provides a real-time overview of air quality conditions across the country. Complementing this, the Ministry has operationalised a centralised digital dashboard for the collection and management of air-quality monitoring data from local environmental authorities.

The dashboard replaces the previous reliance on fragmented submissions with a standardised national digital workflow that supports data quality assurance, analysis and national reporting.

Emirati women advance future vision through artificial intelligence

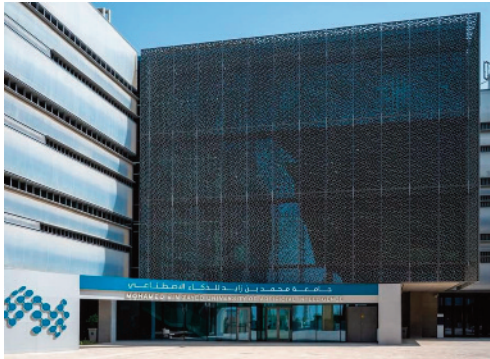
Emirati women's participation in science and technology is an active contribution to knowledge creation

As artificial intelligence (AI) continues to advance at an accelerating pace, Emirati women's participation in science and technology is no longer simply a notable presence, but an active contribution to knowledge creation and shaping the future, supported by a national ecosystem that has made education, scientific research and innovation key pillars of development.

Among the Emirati figures who have chosen scientific research as both a career and an intel-

This field presents genuine scientific challenges because of the wide diversity of Arabic dialects —WAM

numerous opportunities to pursue advanced education and build careers in scientific research and artificial intelligence within the country, not-

ing the growing interest among Emirati students in this path.

Her own journey reflects this support. Aldarmaki completed postgraduate studies in the United Kingdom and the United States before returning to the UAE with the expertise she had gained to build a career in research and teaching and help make this path more visible and accessible to Emirati students aspiring to enter the field.

She holds a PhD in Computer Science from George Washington University and an MPhil from the University of Cambridge.

When she joined MBZUAI in 2022, Aldarmaki became the first woman and first Emirati to join the university's faculty.

She continues today to conduct research, teach and supervise the next generation of AI researchers, alongside leading the university's Center of Teaching and Learning.
