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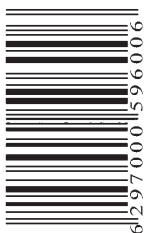

UAE advances peace efforts through mediation, humanitarian action

The UAE continues to advance efforts in support of peace and stability through dialogue, diplomacy, humanitarian action and international cooperation, based on an approach that places conflict prevention, confidence-building and the protection of civilians alongside efforts to resolve existing crises.

As the world marks the International Day of Peace on 21st September, the UAE's activities during 2026 have spanned direct mediation in international conflicts, support for United Nations peace operations, political and humanitarian engagement in regional crises, and partnerships aimed at conflict prevention and peacebuilding.

In the Ukraine crisis, UAE mediation continued during 2026 alongside humanitarian efforts to mitigate the consequences of the conflict.

In August, the UAE announced the success of a new mediation effort that resulted in the exchange of 206 captives, with 103 released from each side.

The exchange brought the total number of captives released through 26 UAE mediation efforts since the outbreak of the crisis to 7,997.

As the world marks the International Day of Peace on 21st September, the UAE's activities during 2026 have spanned direct mediation in international conflicts, support for United Nations peace operations, political and humanitarian engagement in regional crises, and partnerships aimed at conflict prevention and peacebuilding

The UAE also hosted two rounds of trilateral talks between the United States, Russia and Ukraine in Abu Dhabi in January and February as part of diplomatic efforts to advance a political solution to the crisis.

In Sudan, the UAE has combined diplomatic engagement with humanitarian assistance, calling for an immediate and unconditional humanitarian truce leading to a permanent ceasefire, unhindered humanitarian access and a political process leading to an independent civilian-led government.

Four UAE humanitarian aid convoys entered the Gaza Strip this week, comprising 57 trucks and nine water tankers, as part of Operation Chivalrous Knight 3 and the UAE's ongoing efforts to support the Palestinian people and meet their basic needs.

The trucks carried 781 tonnes of humanitarian assistance, including food and shelter supplies, alongside the water tankers, helping strengthen the humanitarian response and alleviate the suffering of Palestinians.

The latest deliveries bring the

total number of trucks that have entered the Gaza Strip under Operation Chivalrous Knight 3 since its launch to 14,290, carrying a combined 136,439 tonnes of humanitarian assistance.

The Operation Chivalrous Knight 3 team continues to prepare aid convoys through the UAE Humanitarian Aid Logistics Centre in Al Arish.

The centre operates through an integrated system covering the receipt, sorting and preparation of assistance and its dispatch to the Gaza Strip, helping ensure the continued flow of humanitarian supplies and their delivery to those in need.

Etihad Rail, AD Ports launch integrated rail service from Fujairah to ICAD

The logistics rail depot solution combines a new dedicated rail freight service, and an inland cargo gateway designed to bring trade closer to customers

Etihad Rail, the developer and operator of the UAE National Rail Network, and AD Ports Group, a global enabler of integrated trade, industry and logistics solutions, have partnered to launch a direct rail service connecting Fujairah Terminals with the Industrial City of Abu Dhabi (ICAD).

The integrated inland logistics rail depot solution, linking one of the UAE's East Coast maritime gateways on the Gulf of Oman with the nation's industrial heartland in the capital Abu Dhabi, combines a new dedicated rail freight service, and a customs-enabled inland cargo gateway designed to bring trade closer to customers.

Developed in partnership with AD Ports Group, Etihad Rail extends the reach of Fujairah Terminals beyond the port gates by enabling cargo arriving in Fujairah to be transported directly by rail approximately 200 km to ICAD, where customers can access customs clearance, inspection and cargo release services.

A key milestone underpinning the launch is the designation of ICAD with its own UN



As part of the wider AD Ports Group ecosystem, Fujairah Terminals plays a vital role in delivering integrated, end-to-end supply chain solutions, connecting ports, industrial and free zones, logistics platforms, and digital services —WAM

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LOCODE "AECAD", establishing it as a recognised international logistics location within global shipping and trade systems.

For the first time, shipping lines, freight forwarders, and cargo owners can book cargo directly to ICAD as the destination and clearance point.

Combined with dedicated customs and inspection infrastructure, this enables containers arriving at Fujairah Terminals to be transported directly by rail to ICAD for inspection, clearance, and release,

simplifying customs processes, reducing handling requirements, and accelerating the movement of goods across Abu Dhabi.

The solution is designed to serve importers, exporters, manufacturers, distributors, and logistics providers operating across Abu Dhabi, allowing them to receive cargo closer to warehouses, production facilities, and end markets.

The new service offers customers reliable schedules, reduced road congestion, enhanced scalability for high-volume cargo movements and lower carbon emissions compared with traditional long-haul trucking.

Operating three times per week, the dedicated Etihad Rail service connects Fujairah Terminals with ICAD, strengthening multimodal cargo flows across the corridor.

Omar Alsebeyi, Chief Executive Officer, Etihad Rail Freight, said, "The launch of our new Fujairah-ICAD rail service represents another important step in unlocking the full potential of the UAE National Rail Network for our customers."

Al Hashemi said the agreement establishes a specialised education and training pathway for Emirati students, developing their capabilities and preparing them for employment opportunities aligned with future labour market needs and municipal specialisations.

He added that combining academic and field-based learning will strengthen students' educational and professional development while enabling them to contribute to the future of municipal work.

UAE smart feeder processes 15 million images to monitor wildlife feeding

DUBAI / WAM

A UAE-developed smart wildlife feeder is using artificial intelligence to identify animals, monitor their numbers and consumption, and automatically adjust feed quantities based on real-time data.

Developed by Dub Dev Technology, the "Mgh-zlan Smart Feeder" combines computer vision, Internet of Things technology and solar power, allowing wildlife feeding and monitoring operations to be managed remotely.

The system processes more than 15 million images annually, with field monitoring recording animal classification confidence levels of between 80 and 97 percent in most cases. It has dispensed more than 50 tonnes of feed in a year and has been deployed in more than three countries.
